
TECHNICAL RIDER COLLECTIF CHIEN ASSIS "Histoires à s'asseoir debout"

(mise à jour 07/2023)

"Histoires à s'asseoir debout" is a visual and sound show
- the manufacture of images put to sound
and sounds made visual, all projected and played by two
multi- disciplinary artists and two multiinstrumentalist musicians.



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THE TEAM:

- The artistic team consists of 4 artists on stage: 2 puppeteers and visual artists, and 2 musicians. Camille Renault, Ayelén Cantini, Julien Jacquin, Julien Rodriguez.

The team is responsible for setting up the screen with the assistance of a technician (minimum) from the stage crew.

INSTALLATION:

Unloading and setup time, sound balance, and projector focus take 3 to 4 hours depending on the setup. Then, 1 to 2 hours of adjustments (to be redefined for festival conditions).

TYPICAL SCHEDULE:

- Unloading and setup: Approximately 3 hours (depending on the number of technicians available on-site).
- Balance/focus: 1 hour.
- Adjustments: 1 to 2 hours (depending on conditions and available time, no need for a technician during this time).
- Performance: 50 to 60 minutes.
- Dismantling: 2 hours.

A technician will be required during the screen setup to handle the venue's equipment, plus one sound operator or stage manager to set up the sound.

PLAYING SPACE:

- Ideal stage size: 12x13m.
- Distance between the screen and the projectors: Minimum
- 7.50m and maximum 16m.
- Minimum height under rigging: 4m.
- Screen size: 4x4m to 4x6m depending on the audience size.
- Space can be completely darkened.
- To install wire systems effectively, we need to know the type of flooring on-site (parquet, dance floor, concrete, earth, etc.).

STAGE TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 4 platforms at a height of 40cm for the projectors (additional platforms may be needed based on the arrangement and audience size for the musicians).
- Seating for the audience, preferably in this order: deck chairs, stools, bean bags, cushions, benches (since the show allows viewing from both directions, it's preferable to prioritize seats without backs that impose a specific direction).
- 2 Keyboard stands in an X shape.
- Weights to secure our wire manipulation systems $(4 \times 20 \text{kg})$.
- A hanging system for the screen (Venetian blinds) with a total weight of approximately 200 kg (either a bridge, grid, or rigging) with a minimum height of 4m (see stage plan). The hanging system needs to be agreed upon in advance.
- 2 drapes and 1 border to create a frame around the projection surface.
- Access to a nearby water source.

ELECTRICITY:

- 1 16A power outlet + power strip in the center for the musicians.
- 1 16A power outlet + power strip for the projectors (if possible, separate music and projection to minimize sound interference).

SOUND:

- Provide a sound diffusion system suitable for the venue and audience size. Basic requirements include: stereo speakers (Kara, 2x PS15, or 2x mtd 115 + 2 subs SB 18 or equivalent Nexo...).
- 4-track patch with 2 stereo inputs in DI or direct depending on the location, of the mixing (Yamaha QL/CL series, Midas Pro, Allen&Heath).
- 1 16A power outlet plus 2 power strips.
- 2 microphone stands.


LIGHTS:

- 2 power lines, 16A direct, from the screen to the projectors (see stage plan).
- 4 straight microphone stands.
- Equipment for a public entrance depending on the venue's setup.
- 3 shower lights to illuminate the 2 puppeteers/projectors and the musicians.

SHOW CHARACTERISTICS:

- Audience: All ages, starting from 8 years old for groups/schools.
- Duration: 50 to 60 minutes (can be divided) to be defined with the "Collectif Chien Assis" and the program.
- Layout: Immersive.
- The audience size will depend on each setup.
- The show includes some moments with short and low-intensity stroboscopic effects.


STAGE LAYOUT








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
